Levy Refund Administration fee

• As the cost of administrating the levy refunds have increase significantly (stamps 1.07/cheq fee\$1.10, audit fee, admin fee of processing) should there be a \$10.00 service fee?

- After dealer fee and PCO fees, SK retains \$1.93 of the 2.00, then pay out to CCA operations/legal as well as Industry partner memberships (NCFA) and research dollars approx .96 remains for operations of SCA.
- Instead of penalizing the producers that leave their dollar in the system and uses it to leverage outside funds to further enhance and grow the beef cattle industry, it is thought that the refunder should pay for the admin fee as they choose to remove themselves from potential Provincial growth.
